I would like to take this opportunity to inform you of some new and exciting things with the Alumni Association. As was mentioned in the last message, the spring event this year is going to be the Gala at Sequassen starting at 5:30PM on June 9<sup>th</sup> with the spring meeting occurring just prior to the event starting at 4:30PM. We are also continuing the Alumni Days at Sequassen each Wednesday evening this year during the firehose competition down at the Bogan Waterfront.

Recently, we have updated our website to increase the functionality and availability of information.
