As the leaves begin to change and the temperatures slowly fall, Sequassen is also undergoing some major changes. The second phase of the Bogan Waterfront renovation is well underway. The concrete blocks for the Dave Farley classroom have been put in (see picture below), replacing the old retaining wall that was partially rotted and leaning significantly at the beach level where scouts would sit for merit badge instruction. The new retaining wall/classroom is a beautiful addition to the aquatic area of Sequassen with room to fit approx. 200 people and the drainage necessary to ensure it remains for many years to come. In the coming months, the upper section of the project will be completed with a pavilion and grassy area that will compliment the classroom and make out waterfront one of the most picturesque locations on West Hill Pond.

I would like to extend my thanks to all who have helped in the fundraising efforts as well as all those who will be working on the construction involved in the viewing area above. This was a major undertaking and it could not have been completed without the support of many people. This gets me thinking about the last 4 years of the Alumni Association.
